2: Improved health and healthy living environment for up to 90 resettled families in Roma Mahalla

3: Economic development and livelihoods initiatives to support a more durable reintegration.

4: Improved access to basic social services (education, civil registration and legal assistance)

5: Improve the capacity of municipal-level government structures in Mitrovicë/a to lead the long-term peaceful reintegration of RAE

6: Community development activities to facilitate sustained, peaceful reintegration of RAE families

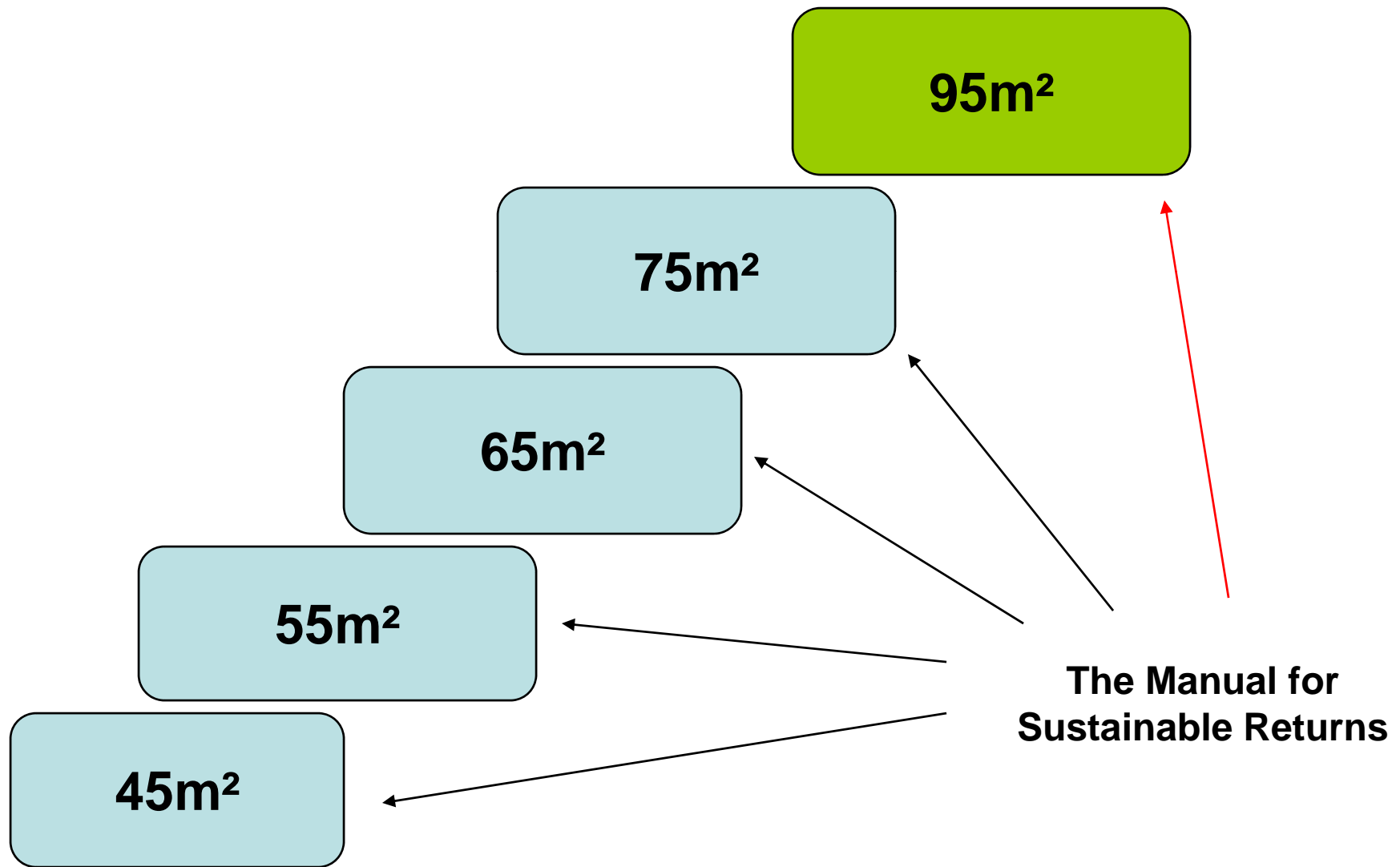
